SOUTH CAROLINA MILLER AFFIDAVIT APPLICATION

Pursuant to Section 46-41-25 of the South Carolina Code of Laws as amended (1981), you may apply for a Miller Exemption Certificate which exempts qualified applicants from being licensed as a South Carolina Dealer and Handler of Agricultural Products.

Failure to submit the proper applications will result in the forfeiture of your right to perform or assist in performing the duties of a Dealer and Handler of Agricultural Products in the state of South Carolina. Furthermore, to perform these duties without a proper license or exemption certificate is a breach of State Law and punishable by fine or imprisonment.
